Date: 21-04-2023

Timings: 12.00 to 1.00 pm

Venue: Seminar Hall

Theme: Journey of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar

Rules for Poster Making Competition:

- There must be minimum of 2 and maximum of 3 members in a team, and allotted time will be for 50 minutes.
- The poster must be made on the A3 size (11.7 * 16.5 inches) sheet with margins (0.5 inches) drawn with black pen/marker.
- Poster can be made using pencil, crayon, watercolor, oil paint, etc. Photographs, wires, other 3D objects, print-outs can be acceptable. It should be original and handmade.
- The Topic of poster and theme should be clearly mentioned at the Top Margin of the Poster and the theme should be the main focus of the poster.
- Student can explain their posters in English language only.
- Name and class/course must be clearly mentioned on the back of poster in the English Language.
- Scoring will be done on basis of neat and clean work as well as idea of painting.
- Judges' decisions will be considered final and binding.

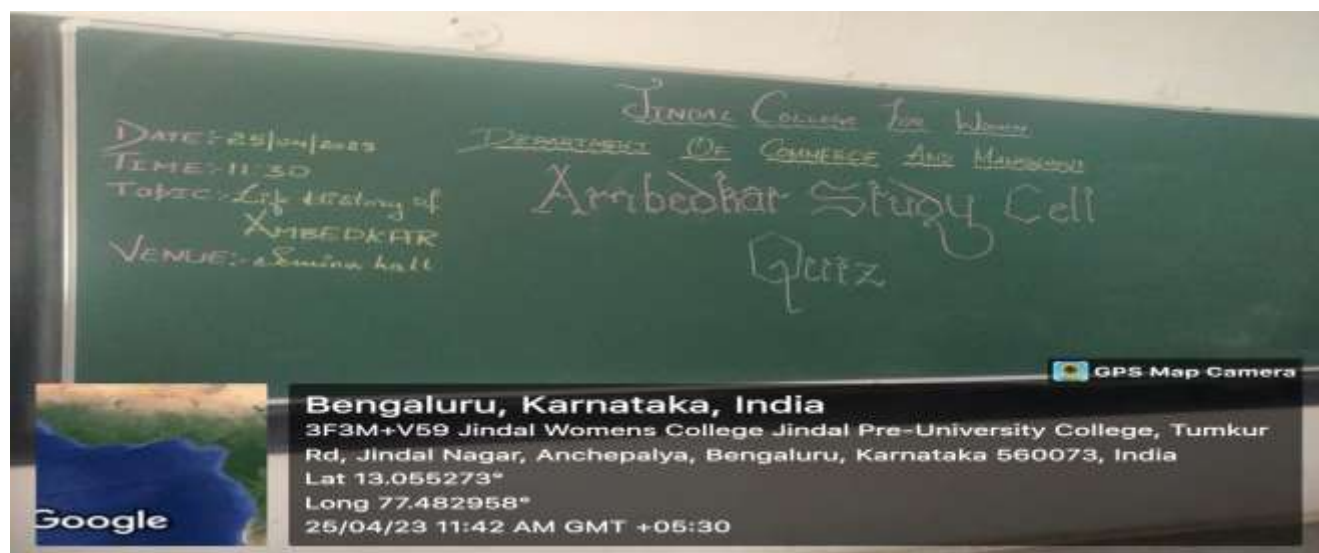
