Anti Ragging Cell Annual Report 2019-20

Anti-Ragging Committee is the Supervisory and Advisory Committee in preserving a Culture of Ragging Free Environment in the college Campus as per the order of Supreme Court of India and subsequent Notification from University Grants Commission (UGC).

Ragging is a heinous crime and a criminal offence as declared by the Supreme Court of India. Jindal College for Women believes in fostering a harmonious relationship amongst its students and strictly condemns ragging. We have an Anti – Ragging Cell. The students are sensitized on the ill effects of ragging and the legal proceedings in curbing the practice. Awareness is created during orientation programme in the beginning of each academic year as well as before the commencement of each semester.

The cell briefed out anti ragging guidelines prescribed by UGC on orientation day. The cell collected the undertakings by the students and ensured that they are abided by the rules and regulations of the Cell. Coming forth semester also through class teachers students were given instruction about the Anti ragging cell provisions. Anti Ragging Committee engage in monitoring places like Class rooms, corridors, and Canteen.
