Introduction:

World Environment Day was celebrated on 5 June to increase awareness about environmental issues. It is important for a college teach to students about the importance of environmental preservation as this will help them learn about real-world issues, appreciate nature and use natural resources carefully. Eco clubs in our college will empower students to participate and take up meaningful environmental activities and projects. It is a forum through which students can reach out to influence, engage their parents and neighbourhood communities to promote sound environmental behaviour. It will empower students to explore environmental concepts and actions beyond the confines of a syllabus or curriculum. While everyone, everywhere, asserts the importance of 'learning to live sustainably,' environment remains a peripheral issue in the formal education system.

We Motivated the students to keep their surroundings green and clean by undertaking plantation of trees. 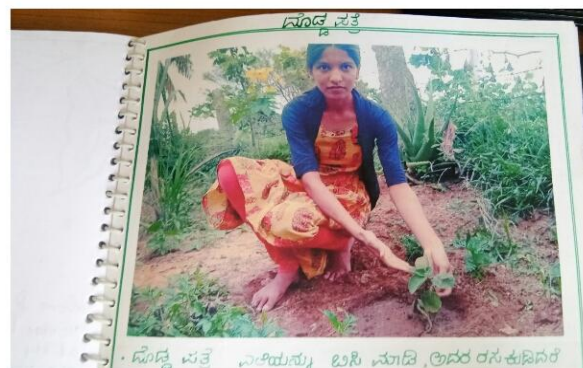
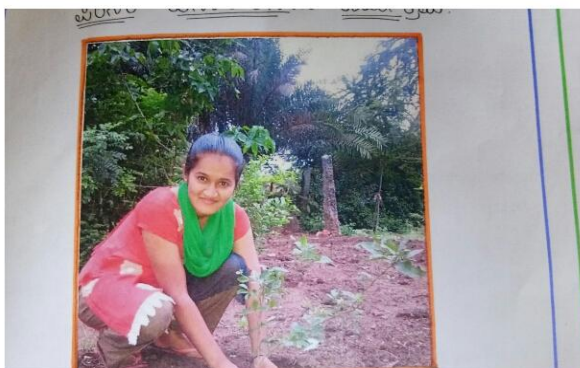
