## DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE - UG

Admissions: 150 students were admitted for Commerce Stream from various PU Colleges. The admission process commenced from the month of July.

Orientation Program: Orientation Program was organized on 14th September 2022 for the 1st year students. The students were given guidance about the NEP syllabus as well as the subjects offered under NEP syllabus. Mr. B Suresh Gowda BA, LLB was the Chief Guest.
