I BEST PRACTICE : BEST LIBRARY USER AWARD

THE PRACTICE : To promote maximum and proper utilization of Library facilities and services the Library Advisory Committee proposed to introduce the Best Library User Award to the Students and Faculty every month who make maximum use of the library resources and facilities and to display the Names of the same on the Notice Board of the Library. This practice motivates the students and Faculty to make the efficient use of the library and its services. This practice has been introduced from the year 2021.

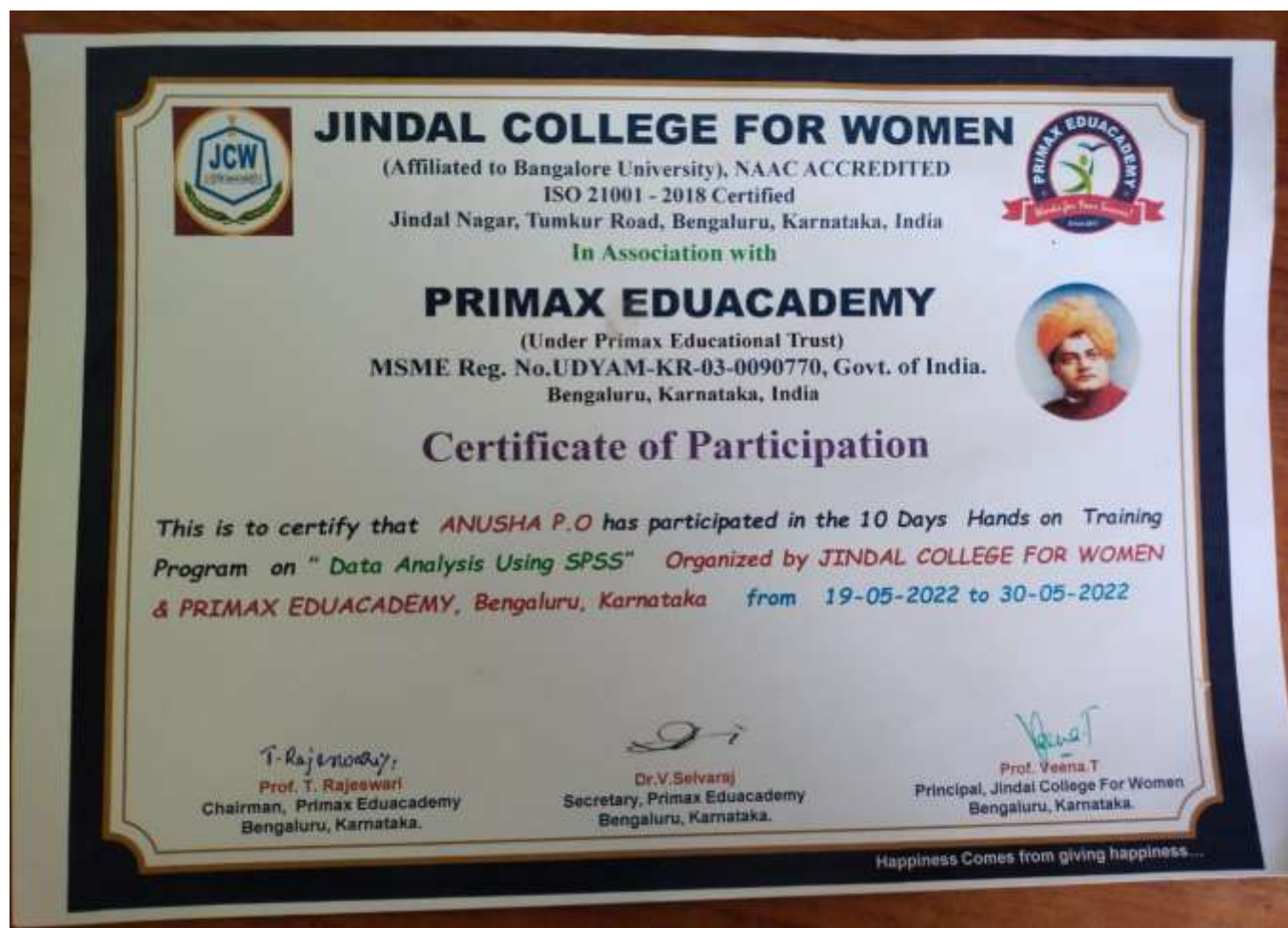
