A report on industrial visit organized by Jindal first grade College for Women, for the students to get the practical knowledge

1. Industrial Visit for two days i.e., 05-08-2019 and 06-08-2019 was organized for first year students to **Jindal Aluminum Limited**. It focuses on preparing the students to learn about the day-to-day workings of a particular industry and understand its operational issues. The visit also helps the students to keep update regarding the current management practices followed by the organizations and acquire traits that the industry demands from them.

2. Department of physics organized, visit to science fest “**Vigyan Samagam**” at *Vishweshwariyya Museum*, Kasturba road on 14th Aug. 2019 for final year B.Sc. students, where Dr. Shasvath J. Kapadia who is a research fellow from LIGO gave special talk on “**Gravitational waves**”, in this talk, students were introduced to new field of Astrophysics like the motion of stellar bodies, the black holes and binary stars etc

3. On 31st August 2019 department of Chemistry organized one day Industrial Visit to **Mylan Laboratories Limited**, Jigani, Bangalore for II and III B.Sc students along with 2 faculty members to learn about the production of medicine, handling, working environment, employment practices in industries and other facilities which offers to its employees.

On 23-10-2019 Department Of Commerce, Management and science organized one day **industrial trip** for final year students to Solar and Wind power plant which is located in Bhavihalu, Davanagere (D), Madakaripura, Chitradurga (D). Students learnt about how human activity is overloading our atmosphere with carbon dioxide and other global warming emissions. further applications which allow us to replace carbon-intensive energy sources and significantly reduce global warming emissions.
