Industrial Visit focuses on preparing the students to learn about the day-to-day workings of a particular industry and understand its operational issues. The visit also helps the students to keep update regarding the current management practices followed by the organizations and acquire traits that the industry demands from them. Industry visit is an integral part of the University Curriculum. It ensures that students gain practical insights to industry operations in their respective areas of specialization.

1. A Industrial visit to JINDAL ALUMINIUM LTD was organized by the Department of Commerce & Management, Science and Computer applications for I year B.Com, BBA ,BCA and B.Sc students on 1/12/21 and 2/12/21 to enhance their knowledge on working procedures of industrial sector.

Students visited the Industry at 10.00 am batch wise. The following department heads briefed about the operations of the Industry.

Mr. U S Sahoo briefed about the organization and functions like:

- Melting the Al in order to convert it to fluid, Quality check, bending it to desired shapes.
- Tool Shop (Dye Making), Rolling mill division
- In – house power coating, Quality assurance
- Flat Rolled Products production process
- Various initiatives taken under CSR like MCH, MACCI and Scholarship facility etc.

Mr. U S Sahoo and Mr. Anil Kumar – General Manager, Production department also gave detailed information on importing of pure Aluminum from different companies like *Hindalco*, *NALCO* etc. For the preparation of different profiles of Al (chemical symbol of Aluminum) like rods, logs, sheets, spare parts used in electric connectors which are also exported to other countries.

- Mr. Ravi – Safety Manager – explained about the safety precautions to be followed during the visit like wearing masks, shoes, gloves and Helmet.
- Mr. Arun – Learning and development officer- briefed about the in house training programs, job opportunities in manufacturing industries in management.
