Introduction

Industrial visit has its own place of importance in a career of a student who is pursuing a professional degree course like M.Com. In fact, it constitutes a part of core course curriculum taught at the college. The objective of an industrial visit is to provide the students an insight regarding the internal working of companies. Today, we all perfectly understand that theoretical knowledge is just not enough for a successful professional career. It is here that by going beyond academics, industrial visit provides students a much relevant practical perspective of the actual work place and the larger world of business. All this makes the importance of Industrial visits all too evident, especially for students pursuing a professional management course like M.Com.

Objectives of Industrial visit

1. To provide the students with an opportunity to learn practically through interaction, working methods and employment practices.
2. To provide the students an exposure to current work practices as opposed to theoretical knowledge being taught at their college classrooms.
3. To assist students to combine their theoretical knowledge of business operations with the practical knowledge of its actual functioning.

Report of the visit

In this regard, PG Department of Commerce organized Industrial visit under the leadership of our Principal Prof Veena T, Convenor Prof. Veena Karagudari and staff member Prof. Savitha to Bedecks Lifestyle Pvt Ltd, #1446/B 11th Cross, 35th Main, JP Nagar 1st Phase Bangalore, Karnataka on 26th June 2024. This visit had helped students to analyze about the complete process of production of cover for mattress and the supply of them to various industries, such as the IKEA, etc.,

About the company-Bedecks LifeStyle Pvt Ltd

This is a manufacturing company, situated in Industrial Area of Harohalli, Bangalore. It manufactures Beds, pillows, sofa covers, sofa sets, cushions for sofa and many more. Bedecks Lifestyle Private Limited is an unlisted private company incorporated on 05 March 2021. It is classified as a private limited company and is in, Karnataka. Its authorized share capital is INR 40.00 lac and the total paid-up capital is INR 30.00 lakh. The Corporate Identification Number (CIN) of Bedecks Lifestyle Private Limited is **U18100KA2021PTC144944**. The GSTIN of the company is 29AAJCB7038B1ZQ. The registered office of Bedecks Lifestyle Private Limited is at #1446/B 11th Cross, 35th Main, JP Nagar 1st Phase Bangalore, Karnataka. It deals with the manufacture of wearing apparel, dressing and dyeing of fur.

The longest serving directors currently on board are **Sujatha Jayaraj and Jingade Gnaneshwara Rao Shilpa** who were appointed on 05 March 2021. They have been on the board for 3 years and 3 months. The visit was led by Mr. Huzaifa, accompanied by 2 faculty members. The students, along with the faculty and eSTORES team arrived at the factory at 11:10 am. On arrival, we were welcomed by the factory Coordinator. He then introduced the company to the students and prepared for the tour of the facility.

The people working in the company had explained regarding the process of manufacturing cover for mattress of different sizes. The first step was the order confirmation. The order confirmation was only through e-mail and then the availability of material in the industry had to be confirmed according to the order. Then it proceeds to the cutting session, where the fabric is being measured and cropped according to the order sizes and it is done batch wise.

The next process was the Sewing session, where all different necessary parts are being sewed together to make a finished product. It includes overlock, darting process, zipper attachment according to the necessity, attachment of label regarding the fabric contents, instructions label.

The next process is the finishing session, where the manufactured product is being checked for any irregularities, any necessary trimming, inspection of the product for any foreign bodies like needle, any iron contents using a machinery which detects the presence of iron or steel contents. Alterations are done, if necessary in the process. This company mainly uses fabric consisting of Aprit, Knitted material, along with cotton, synthetic, polyester.

The final process is the packaging session, where the finished and inspected product is being folded and packed in bags and supplied to the necessary customers of the company.

The company had detail explained regarding the process, enabling the students to gain knowledge about the entire process of manufacturing and the employee co-ordination to produce these products.

The visit was over by noon 1.30PM. Then we had lunch in one of the hotels. Later on we visited the Art of Living foundation on the way. The students enjoyed the serenity of the lush greenery. Few of the students had been to meditation hall where they chanted the mediation mantra for their self-realization. The visit was over in half an hour and then we boarded the bus and returned back to college campus at 4.30 PM.
