This year's campaign is celebrated under the theme #BeatPlasticPollution. It highlights the need to take concrete action to achieve transformative change to tackle the climate crisis. Be it food packets, toys, storage packing, furniture or electronic items, plastics are so widely used that imagining our lives without them is impossible. It is one of the best substitutes for wood, thus reducing the cutting of trees and helping the environment. On the other hand, sometimes it poses problems too, for example: when it comes to their disposal. Upon usage, artifacts made from plastic sustain wear and tear and become brittle, so it is necessary to dispose of.

Our college 32 NCC cadets involved in environment awareness activity. On 3.6.2023 32 cadets visit Govt High School and Bilanjaneya education institution at Gollahalli near Nelmangala created awareness about bad effects of plastic usage and planted saplings in school premises. The NCC cadets created awareness among the students and public by rally.

Programe outcome: 74 students of Govt High school and 88 PU Students of Bilanjaneya college were benefited. Students learn more about bad effect of Plastic usage. Came to know about the improperly disposed of food bags, when eaten by animals, cause stomach and intestine related diseases which even lead to suffocation and death. Proper disposal and usage of plastic discards can reduce these problems.

 On 24th June 2023 our Cadets attended <u>seed boll making program</u> at Magadi which is conducted by Bhavatharini arshram and Art of living organization.

Introduction

The 'Seed Balls Making' activity was conducted by Our college NCC students association with Art of living and Bhatarini Ashram, Magadi as an initiative towards greening the environment. The increasing population is creating pressure on resources, which has resulted in many environmental problems. The forest cover is depleting and the green element of the environment is deteriorating day by day. The aim of this activity was to make the student community as well as public aware about the environment and its conservation.

The objectives of this activity were to involve students in preparing Seed Balls and to put those to Mother Earth innovative manner.

On 24th June 2023, 34 NCC students made Seed Balls of different seeds such as Neem, sitapal, Mongo, Jackfruit, Bamboo . The Seed Balls were made by mixing soil, compost and seeds. The students were instructed by the concerned teachers about the procedure of making the Seed Balls. After making the seed balls, they were kept to dry for 15days. Program planed to put 8th July 2023, to put those to Mother Earth Hills near Thippagondanahalli dam.

Famous ecologist and writer **Mr. Nagesh Hegde** was the chief guest. The guest and Mata Vivekamayi and other dignitaries inaugurated program by making Seed boll. Nagesh Hegde addressed students ecological balance and bad effects of plastic usage. Program targeted to made 30000 seed balls. 200 volunteers from Jindal college, Magadi Frist Grade college, Art of living and Bhavatharini Arshram were involved in seed boll making program.

Program Outcome: Students came knew that seed bolls making is easy way to contribute to greening. 40% of seed boll is successfully grow.

- From Oct 7th to 22nd Oct our cadet Lavanya of III sem BBA attednded **Rock claimbing camp at Gwalior**.






