The **National Service Scheme (NSS)** is an Indian government-sponsored public service program conducted by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports of the Government of India. Popularly known as NSS, the scheme was launched in Gandhiji's Centenary year, 1969. Aimed at developing student's personality through community service, NSS is a voluntary association of young people in Colleges, Universities and at +2 level working for a campus-community linkage. The overall objective of National Service is Educational. This objective is attained through the service to the community.

ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED

Regular Activities:

International Yoga Day:

Yoga is essentially a spiritual discipline based on an extremely subtle Science, which focuses on bringing harmony between mind and body. It is an art and science for healthy living. On the occasion of International Yoga Day was celebrated on 21 June 2019. Mr. Rajeev Rajendran, Yoga Instructor in Jindal Nature Cure was the chief guest who spoke about the importance of Yoga in leading a healthy life. The event was presided by Mr. Deeraj Singh, Dept.
