Regular Activities:

DENTAL CHECK UP CAMP

Our doctors guide the patients about the food intake and daily routine they should follow to prevent dental disorders. However rigorous cases were referred to MCH.

EYE CHECK UP CAMP

A free eye check up was organized by YRC at Honnarayanahalli village on Thursday, July 28, 2022. Dr. Shivalinga swami examined around 70 patients while few of them were referred for eye surgery. The organizers also distributed free medicines and spectacles to the patients in the camp. Such initiatives are helpful for poor people who cannot afford expensive procedures and medicines.

On 17/08/2022 and 21/08/2022 college was organized COVID19 Booster Dose for I, II & III year Degree students. With the help of Public Health center, Makali, Bengaluru. Total 520 students, Teaching and Non teaching Staffs are benefitted from this vaccination drive.

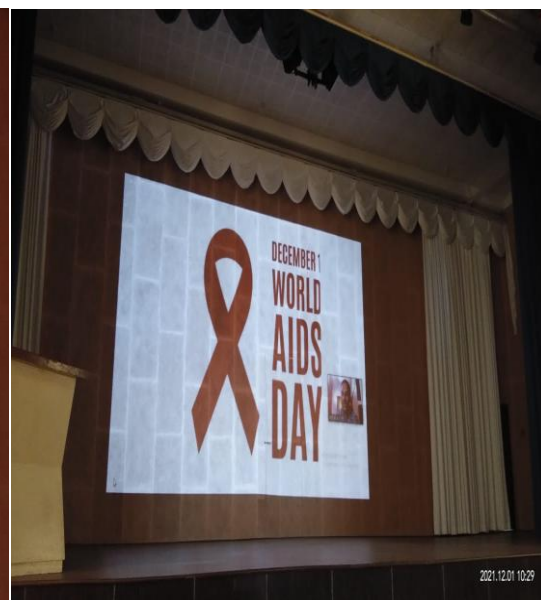
